Activities:

- **GOTV:** Number of individuals served at GOTV sites: total served-815 individuals at the various tabling sites.
- **Candidate Forums:** NM Representative District 50 (9.30); US Representative District 3 (10.7). As of 10.8 the number of online and in person attendees at the two forums was is 510 individuals (approximately 110 in person and 400 on line).
- **GOTV Sites:** Santa Fe Farmers Market; The Food King Market; Santa Fe Community College, Senior Residence, Senior Centers.
- **Canvassing** (Partner with NAACP): To date-229 individuals (either left information or canvassed with commitment to vote).
- **Materials:** Distributed 1,823 copies of League voter information materials to 20 Community Based Organizations, Unhoused Shelters, Senior Centers and Senior Residences.
- **Election Inserts and Voter Guides:** Distribution to 46,000 as an insert in the Santa Fe New Mexican. An additional 800 copies for distribution at tabling sites, high schools, Community Based Organizations and the early voting site at the County Clerks.

Miscellaneous:

- **St Johns Food Pantry:** Distributes Voter Information to Food Pantry consumers. To date: 690 copies of GOTV materials distributed
- **St Vincent Hospital and clinics:** Posts vote411.org on TV monitors and in staff newsletter.
