## 1. REGISTER OR CONFIRM REGISTRATION

**BEST CHOICE: REGISTER OR CONFIRM ONLINE**

**NOW:** Register to vote online at [Santafe.vote](https://www.santafe.vote)  
NM Driver's License and SS# required.  
**Go to:** Election Information/Register to Vote  
**Register to vote at County Clerk's office, or  
request paper application**  
Photo ID required  
**Call:** County Clerk at 505-986-6280  
**Note:** Only use official New Mexico forms.

**May 5:** Last day to register by mail or online.

**Same-Day Registration at all voting locations. Bring Photo ID**

**May 5 to** **County Clerk's Office (240 Grant Ave.)**  
**May 29:** 8:00AM to 5:00PM (Mon thru Fri)

**May 30:** **County Clerk's Office (240 Grant Ave.)**  
10:00AM to 6:00PM (only Saturday)

**May 16 to** **Expanded Early Voting Sites around County**

11:00AM to 7:00PM (Tues thru Fri)  
10:00AM to 6:00PM (Saturdays)

## 2. MAIL IN BALLOT: PERMANENT ABSENTEE

**BEST CHOICE:** ONLINE APPLICATION IS FASTEST AND MOST EFFICIENT WAY TO APPLY

Absentee ballots are mailed upon request from the registered voter. Voters enrolled in the Permanent Absentee Voter List will automatically receive a ballot for each election they are eligible to vote in.

**Now to May 19:** **Online application** request at [Santafe.vote](https://www.santafe.vote).  
**Go to:** Election Information/Absentee

**Paper application.** Available by contacting the County Clerk, or download at [Santafe.vote](https://www.santafe.vote).

Submit application request to County Clerk by the May 19<sup>nd</sup> deadline.

**IMPORTANT :** For timely processing, check [Santafe.vote](https://www.santafe.vote) to make sure your application exactly matches your voter registration info.

## 3. MAIL-IN BALLOT: RECEIVE AND RETURN

**BEST CHOICE:** RETURN EARLY BY MAIL OR USE BALLOT DROPBOXES (see #4 and #6 locations)

**RECEIVE:** Absentee ballots will begin to be mailed to voters who apply starting 2<sup>nd</sup> week of May.

**DEADLINE FOR RETURN:** **Mail Early:** Allow 10 days for mail delivery to County Clerk no later than **Jun 2, 7:00PM**

**In person:** Use ballot dropboxes at locations in #4 and #6, or County Clerk during business hours, no later than Jun 2, 7:00 PM.

**IMPORTANT:** Enter the last 4 digits of your SSN# and signature under the envelope's privacy flap.  
**Go to:** [Santafe.vote](https://www.santafe.vote) Election Info/Check Voter Registration to track your ballot status.  
**Go to:** Election Information/Check Your Vote.

## 4. MAIL-IN BALLOT: DROPBOXES

**BEST CHOICE:** SECURE BALLOT DROPBOXES AT ALL ELECTION DAY AND EARLY VOTING LOCATIONS

## 5. EARLY VOTING-COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE

**BEST CHOICE:** MAIL-IN BALLOT DROPBOX ON OUTSIDE WALL

Mail-in Ballot dropbox is located on outside wall of the walkway into the main building. In-person voting and same-day registration are available inside the main building.
